Open to the Public – Traditional Bows Only

No compounds, crossbows, sights, binoculars, release aids, stabilizers or illuminated nocks

Friday and Saturday Nights: Coon Shoot at Dark (no illuminated nocks).

Saturday: Competition Rounds begin. Competition round consists of 40 targets total.

Shooters may compete in all classes for highest overall score but you must use a different bow for each class entered.

Sunday: Final chance to shoot Competition Rounds, Awards and Raffle.

All scorecards must be turned in by 1:00 pm. Cookout begins at 12:00 p.m.

Scoring – 10, 8, 5, X - Casual Start Saturday and Sunday. Shoot one or both days.

Note: All competition rounds must be completed before shooting any fun rounds.

Shoot Classes and Bow / Arrow combination restrictions:

- Men's & Women's Traditional class - Any arrow and nock combination.
- Men's & Women's Longbow class - Any arrow and nock combination.
- Men's & Women's Primitive class - Wood arrows only - self nocks
- Orange Stakes - Men's Traditional, Longbow & Primitive
- Blue Stakes - Women's & Youth Traditional, Longbow & Primitive
- All Cubs shoot from the White Stakes or pick-a-spot

Several novelty shoots including aerial shooting and long distance shots.

Entry Fees:

- \$15 - Competition Round. Trophy to top 3 places
- \$5 - Coon Shoot. Trophy
- \$10 - Iron Man. 10 targets, one arrow. Green stakes, no classes, 50% payout.
- \$10 - Fun round

Directions: From I-295, south of downtown Jacksonville, Florida - Exit I-295 at exit 10, Roosevelt Blvd. (Hwy 17). Travel north on Roosevelt Blvd. approximately 2.4 miles to Yorktown Ave. There is a traffic light at this intersection. Turn left (west), crossing the railroad tracks to enter the park. The gate entrance for North Florida Archers is 1/2 mile north on Butts Rd/Ellyson St. You will see the club's sign posted on the fence at the gate.
